Supper is served, starting at 6:30 pm, with a Bible study beginning at 7 pm.

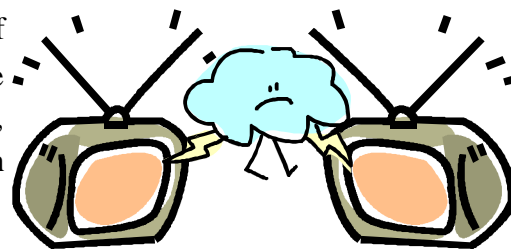
This week John begins a brief new series on the Book of Titus.
